Rules for Garage Sale Signs in Chandler

 Signs shall be located on private property and signs located away from the sale site shall have permission from property owner. (Note: the property owner of the vacant lot at the southwest corner of FM 315 and Hwy 31 does not allow any garage sale signs and has asked the city to remove any sign posted there.)



- Signs are not allowed on utility poles, in easements, on public fences or buildings, or any public or private right-of-way. In order to ensure signs are out of the Right-of-way they should be placed a minimum of 10 feet off curb or pavement.
- All garage and yard sale signs must have the time, date, and place of the sale written on the sign.
- Garage and yard sale signs shall be posted no earlier than 7:00 AM on the day prior to the sale and must be removed by 8:00 PM the day the sale ends. Signs may be posted no longer than 3 consecutive days.
- Signs should be no larger than ordinary poster paper, 24" X 36"

If the sign is posted without the required information, property owner permission, during other time periods or larger than 24" X 36" the sign may be subject to removal and disposal by the City.
